## **Genealogy Research Tools**

## FamilySearch Wiki

FamilySearch is a wonderful, free tool that contains genealogy and family records from around the world. It also contains the <u>FamilySearch Wiki</u> which provides additional resources, strategies, and references for use in your genealogy journey.

As explained by the FamilySearch Wiki site: "The FamilySearch Research Wiki is a free, online genealogical guide created and maintained by <u>FamilySearch</u>, a non-profit organization. It contains links to genealogy databases, websites, other resources, research strategies, and genealogical guidance to assist in the search for your ancestors. Articles included are locality pages for countries around the world and topic pages that include pertinent genealogy record types explaining how to use the record, what it contains, and how to find it."

The Wiki isn't used for searching people, but is a unique tool that can be used to search places and topics, which may lead you to interesting or unknown facts about your ancestors.

#### Search by Country

Searching by Country will provide you with many resources that can help you find, or pinpoint, your ancestors. View a map of your country. Look at Districts, Parishes, Regions, or Counties, and view links to additional resources and research tips pertaining to that country.

#### Search by Categories

Categories available include: images, topic, location, and non-English articles.
