## Genealogy Research Tools

#### **Fun Tools**

Our friends over at Fiske Library found a couple of tools that we thought might interest our fellow genealogist.

GFPGAN - Old photographs can not only provide you with information, but they help to bring you closer to your ancestors but putting faces and families, to names and places. GFPGAN is an online tool that can help to digitally restore old photographs. This tool's features include not only restoring faces in old photos but it can increase the resolution of the photo in question, beneficial if you want to include it in a family history photo book. <u>CloudConvert</u> - Sometimes the digital file you are given isn't in a format that you can use. It may be a pdf you need to edit, an MAC file you want to open on PC, an image file that you wish was anything but an image, or maybe you want to extract some audio from a video file.
