Veterans Day

Friday, November 11, 2022, marks the 75th anniversary of the day we celebrate as Veterans' Day.

Originally started following WWI, November 11th was set aside as Armistice Day. In 1947, a man named Raymond Weeks from Birmingham, AL proposed that November 11th should be a day to celebrate all those who served, not just those who perished during that service. Mr. Weeks was instrumental in his community hosting what is considered the first Veterans Day celebration in 1947. In 1954, Congress passed a bill designating Veterans Day on November 11th of each year.

As we celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the first Veterans Day, Fold3 is offering free access to military records. From November 10th through November 13th, you can search records and create Memorials on their Honor Wall. Visit <u>Fold3's information page</u> to learn more about creating Memorials.

If you, or your loved one, has a story from WWII you can share that with Ancestry.com as they try to preserve these stories. Visit the <u>Ancestry.com Veterans page</u> for interview questions and guidelines on submissions.
