## Genealogy Research Tools

#### **Beyond Genealogy**

If you haven't visited Heritage Park, the home of the Sno-Isle Genealogical Society, lately spring and summer are a great time to visit.

Heritage Park consists of several historical buildings and items, including the Wicker's Building, Humble House, Superintendent's Cottage, Water Tower, and Interurban Car 55. It's a wonderful place to explore and learn more about how Alderwood Manor used to be.

The Wicker's Building features the Northwest Veteran's Museum and Wicker's Museum, which includes 3 rooms recreated with vintage furniture replicating the life of the Wicker's family.

The Superintendent's Cottage is now the home of the Lynnwood-Alderwood Manor Heritage Association and Museum. This museum features rotating exhibits and photographs, including information about the 33-acre Demonstration Farm where the building was originally located.

Humble House, home of the Sno-Isle Genealogical Society, The original residence located at the park, Humble House was built in 1919 and originally featured only 2 rooms. Expanded after the Humble Family purchased it in 1934 it now houses genealogy resources from the local area, the United States, and various countries around the world.

The Water Tower is located behind Humble House and had renovations completed in 2022. Originally built on the Demonstration Farm to provide water to the farm and surrounding residences, the water tower was powered by an electric pump through an underground connection to the interurban trolley.

Interurban Car No. 55 is one of six interurban electric rail cars that provided service from Alderwood Manor to Seattle and Everett between 1910 and 1939.


In addition to the historical buildings, the park features a play area and grassy lawns.

While many of these attractions have regular hours, like Humble House, the Water Tower and Trolley are usually accessible during special events such as the yearly History and Heritage Days. Mark your calendars for the 2023 History and Heritage Days.
